

1988-1991 Chevrolet/GMC Extended Cab Rear Bench



Step 1. Bottom: Tilt the seat bottom up slightly using the plastic handle located under the passenger side as shown.



Step 2. Bottom: The top of the seat cover has the extending hook and the seat belt cut-outs. Slide the handle through opening in the bottom right of the seat cover.



Step 3. Bottom: Slide the seat cover on all the way and tuck the seat cover over the back edge of the seat on both sides of the seat belt notch.



Step 4. Bottom: Tuck the seat cover behind the plastic cover of the hinge on the bottom left and right side of the seat.



Step 5. Bottom: With the seat tilted slightly up but not all the way, mate the hook straps to the loop



Step 6. Top: Slide the top on with the long hook straps and the seat belt cut-out to the front as shown.

strip sewn inside the back edge as shown.



Step 6. Top: Fold the backrest flat and tuck the seat cover in around the plastic for the hinge.



Step 7. Top: Be sure the seat cover is centered and not twisted so the seams of the cover line up with the seams of the seat.



Step 8. Top: Tilt the backrest forward and tuck the hook straps in the seat and mate them to the loop strip sewn inside the back edge.



Congratulations, you are done. Enjoy your seat cover; it will give you several years of use.
