1998-2004 S-10/Sonoma Bench Seat Installation



Step 1.

Temporarily remove the seat release handles with a Phillips screwdriver. Inside your seat covers you will see the letter "T", which stands for Top and "B" is for the Bottom.

Slide the Top on with the extending hook (sticky) Velcro[™] to the front.





Work the cover down around the integral headrests on the seat top, and form the cover to them. Align the seat cover by lining up the seams of the seat cover to the seams of the seat, they should match closely.



Step 3.

Re-install the seat release handles and tip the seat forward. Tuck the Velcro[™] through to the back and smooth the seat cover.



Step 4.

While pulling on the Velcro[™] from the back, use the other hand in a smoothing action in front from top to bottom, then pin the Velcro[™] to the seat with the front hand (shown) and press the loop Velcro[™] onto it with the other hand.



Step 5.

Temporarily remove the drink holders (on models 2000-2004) by lifting up on the release lever under the front and slide it forward. Place the seat cover on with the long hook Velcro[™] to the front. Feed the seat belts through the provided openings



Step 7.

Slide the side hook Velcro[™] in where shown, over the top of the seat slide



Step 9.

Route the long hook Velcro[™] under the front of the seat, avoiding the seat slide wire, and press them onto the carpet on the back edge of the seat. Use one hand in a smoothing action from front to back as in Step 4.



Step 6.

Pull the left and right side of the seat cover around back and mate the hook Velcro[™] low on the seat bottom to avoid the seat hook.



Pull it tight and mate it to the carpet on the back of the seat at roughly a 45 degree angle.



Step 10. Lastly, tuck in the back edge, pull it back hard, and mate the hook Velcro[™] to the carpet on the seat bottom.
