## 2007-2014 Chevy/GMC Crew Cab Rear Installation



Step 1. Driver & Passenger Top DT&PT:

Slide the headrest covers on (follow Step 2) before removing the headrests. Temporarily remove the headrests by lifting them up all the way holding gentle upward pressure and insert a heavy paper clip into the hole in the plastic until it releases. Keep holding upward pressure and release the other side of the headrest.



Step 2. Headrests/H:

All the parts of the seat cover are labeled inside. Use the seat cover piece identification chart to ID parts. Slide the headrest cover on with the extending hook (sticky)  $\text{Velcro}^{\text{TM}} \text{ to the front. Tuck them inside the back edge and connect them to the loop (fuzzy) } \text{Velcro}^{\text{TM}} \text{ sewn inside the back edge.}$ 



Step 3. Driver's Top/DT:

Tuck the seat cover behind the seatbelt and turn the top of the seat cover inside out to keep the hook  $Velcro^{TM}$  from connecting to the carpet behind the backrest.



Step 4. Driver's Top/DT:

Fold the armrest partway down and tuck the material around the armrest.



Step 5. Driver & Passenger Top/DT&PT:

Tuck the seat cover fabric under the plastic for the headrests.



Step 6. Driver & Passenger Top/DT&PT:

Tuck the seat cover in behind the plastic on the inside and outside edge.



Step 7. Driver's Top/DT:

Tuck the seat cover fabric behind the metal hinge for the armrest.



Step 8. Driver's Top/DT:

Tuck the sides and bottom of the armrest cavity fabric behind the plastic lip.



Step 9. Driver's Top/DT:

Tuck the top corners of the material behind the plastic using a shoe horn or some other rounded corner tool.



Step 10. Driver's Top/DT:

Using the shoe horn tuck the fabric in on the top. Do it by pushing it in and down behind the plastic.




Step 11. Driver & Passenger Top/DT&PT:

Lift the seat bottom part way up and tuck the long hook Velcro's™ into the seat, then flip the seat bottoms up. Laying on the floor of the truck, fold the Velcro™ in half lengthwise and push them up towards the window.



Step 12. Driver & Passenger Top/DT&PT:

Reach down from the top and connect the Velcro $^{\text{TM}}$  to the carpet on the back of the seat. Use a smoothing action with one hand down the front while pulling on the Velcro $^{\text{TM}}$  to tighten the cover.




Step 13. Driver & Passenger Top/DT&PT:

Mate the hook Velcro<sup>™</sup> sewn inside the back of the seat cover to the carpet behind the top of the seat.



Step 14. Driver & Passenger Top/DT&PT:

Do this by tucking the right and left corner hook  $Velcro^{TM}$  into the seat.



Step 15. Driver & Passenger Top/DT&PT:

Lift the seat bottoms up, route the long right and left corner hook Velcro<sup>™</sup> around to the side of the seat and connect them to the loop Velcro<sup>™</sup> sewn in the side. Carefully move the seat bottoms up and make sure the action of the seat is not being interfered with. Some reconnecting of the Velcro<sup>™</sup> may be needed to get the best fit. Lastly, connect the hook Velcro<sup>™</sup> on top of the cover to the carpet on the back of the seat below the rear window.



Step 16. Driver and Passenger Bottoms/DB&PB:

With the seat bottoms tilted up slide the seat covers on with DB and PB up (labeled inside the seat cover). Turn the Velcro™ away from the carpet while sliding it down to keep it from attaching prematurely.



Step 17. Driver and Passenger Bottoms/DB&PB:

Tuck the fabric of the seat cover behind the plastic on the outside edge of the seat.



Step 18 Driver and Passenger Bottoms/DB&PB:

Tuck the back left and right of the seat covers around the back corners of the seat.



Step 19 Driver and Passenger Bottoms/DB&PB:

Tuck the hook Velcro<sup>TM</sup> into the seat and press them to the carpet under the seat. Do this by gently pulling the hook Velcro<sup>TM</sup> with one hand and use your other hand in a smoothing action from the front of the seat to the back.



Step 20. Driver and Passenger Bottoms/DBPB:

Press the hook  $Velcro^{TM}$  sewn inside the bottom edge to the carpet under the seat starting in the middle and work your way out.



**Step 21. Driver and Passenger Bottoms DBPB:** Tuck the fabric behind the plastic under the seat on the outside edge.



**Step 22. Armrest/A:** Slide the armrest covers on with the opening for the drink holders on top.



Step 23. Armrest/A:
Feed the pull strap from your armrest through the provided opening in the cover.



**Step 24. Armrest/A:**Tuck the fabric under the plastic for the drink holders in front.



**Step 25. Armrest/A:**Continue tucking the fabric along the sides, and then under the back of the plastic. The fit is very snug to avoid shifting.



Step 26. Armrest/A:

Tuck the fabric around the hinges on left and right and pull the cover all the way on. Tuck the hook Velcro™ under the front of the armrest and connect it to the loop Velcro™ sewn inside the back edge.
