2004-2008 F-150 Super Cab Rear 60/40 Installation



Step 1. Top/T: Remove the headrests by lifting them up all the way using the push button release on the right side. Next, use gentle upward pressure and depress the semihidden push button release on the left.



Step 3. Top/T: Tuck the fabric under the plastic for the headrests and slide the seat cover behind the top of the seat.



Step 5. Top/T: Tuck the left and right side hook (sticky) Velcro[™] into the seat, lift the seat foam up and tuck the seat cover above child restraints all along the front edge. Pull the Velcro[™] tight and press it to the carpet on the side of seat.



Step 2. Top/T:

All the parts of the seat cover are labeled inside. Use the seat cover piece identification chart to ID parts. Slide the seat cover behind the seat belt, over the top of the seat and tuck the fabric under the plastic box for the seatbelt, and connect the Velcro[™] behind it.



Step 4. Top/T: Carefully tuck the bottom of the seat cover over the child restraints located where the bottom meets the backrest.



Step 6. Top/T:

Tuck the sides of the seat cover in, keeping the side Velcro[™] turned away from the seat as shown. Line up the seams of the seat cover to the seams of the seat, they should closely match. Connect the side hook Velcro[™] to the carpet on the seat by pushing the seat cover in and down.
